- Library staff have recommended 557 Wellington St. (west of Bronson) as the site for the new Central Library
- 584,650 people visited the Main library in 2015 = 1670/day
- 81% of current Main library users arrive on foot
- 24% visit from downtown workplaces = 500+/day
- According to Ottawa Public Library staff, if the central Main branch moves, there is no plan for a Centretown branch
