



**Artwork Guidelines** Artwork should be submitted in a digital format by email to echo@lowertown-basseville.ca. Ideally, artwork should be black and white, at a resolution of 300 dpi, and in PDF or JPG/BMP file formats. Please limit file sizes to a maximum of 6 MBs.

**Editorial Calendar/Deadlines** Artwork is due at least two weeks before delivery of each issue. Our annual publication dates are:

Mar/April	Two Weeks Before Delivery	Last Weekend of February
May/June	Two Weeks Before Delivery	Last Weekend of April
July/Aug	Two Weeks Before Delivery	Last Weekend of June
Sept/Oct	Two Weeks Before Delivery	Last Weekend of August
Nov/Dec	Two Weeks Before Delivery	Last Weekend of October
